Turn your art quilts into dramatic wall art!

Pictured is a 12" x 16" stenciled and pieced "Iris" art quilt wrapped on a 12" x 16" x 1 1/2" gallery-stretched canvas.



1. Square off quilt to exact size of canvas **plus** 1/4" all around for seam. Cut a strip of coordinating fabric 3 1/2" to 4" x 60"
2. Sew strip onto quilt using 1/4" seam, overlap beginning and ending as shown. Trim corners.
3. Press seam away from quilt and pull over canvas. This should fit snugly.
4. Staple fabric strip to back of stretcher bars; miter corners neatly and fold under edges.
5. Complete by adding a wire hanger.
