

## “Color 101 for Quilters - 3 hours

Learning how to use color is one of the most important steps in making fabulous quilts. In this class students will learn the basics of color theory using actual fabric swatches for hands on color exercises. We will begin by creating a 12 part color wheel and then move on to basic color harmonies and value charts. See color in action with samples of quilts and fabric. Students will learn how to use a color wheel to make smart color choices and take home a handy reference to make their next quilt their own with personal color choices.
