\* 5 hour - Bring your sewing machine and batting for finishing methods

This is a delightful class! You will learn an easy way to applique with raw edge technique and fusible web. Learn how to add amazing realistic birch shading with Copic markers. Several methods of completing your landscape will be presented; how to mount a landscape on artist canvas and no sew fused borders. Finished size is 16" x 20"

Includes: pattern, all fabric, fusible and use of art materials to complete one 16" x 20" landscape

### Supplies to Bring

**(NO sewing machine required for 3 hour class)**

- \* Heat resistant, transparent pressing sheet  
18" x 21" Applique Pressing Sheet™ Bear Creek (recommended)
- \* Small fabric scissors - Fiskars 5" Spring Assist Micro-tip (recommended)
- \* Regular fabric scissors and paper scissors
- \* Notebook and pencil
- \* Small bag for scraps
- \* Camera or cell phone to take photos
- \* 12" straight edge ruler
